


Data Feed Instructions

1. Login to Locator IDX account at <https://locatoridx.com>.
2. Go to Data Feeds.
3. Select Dynamic Search or Static Search.
4. Add properties to the data feed.
5. Click "Open Data Feed" and copy the URL.
6. Login to WordPress - you should have already installed <https://www.wpallimport.com/>
7. Click All Import -> New Import -> New Download -> From URL -> Paste the Data Feed URL
8. Click Next through their drag and drop interface.

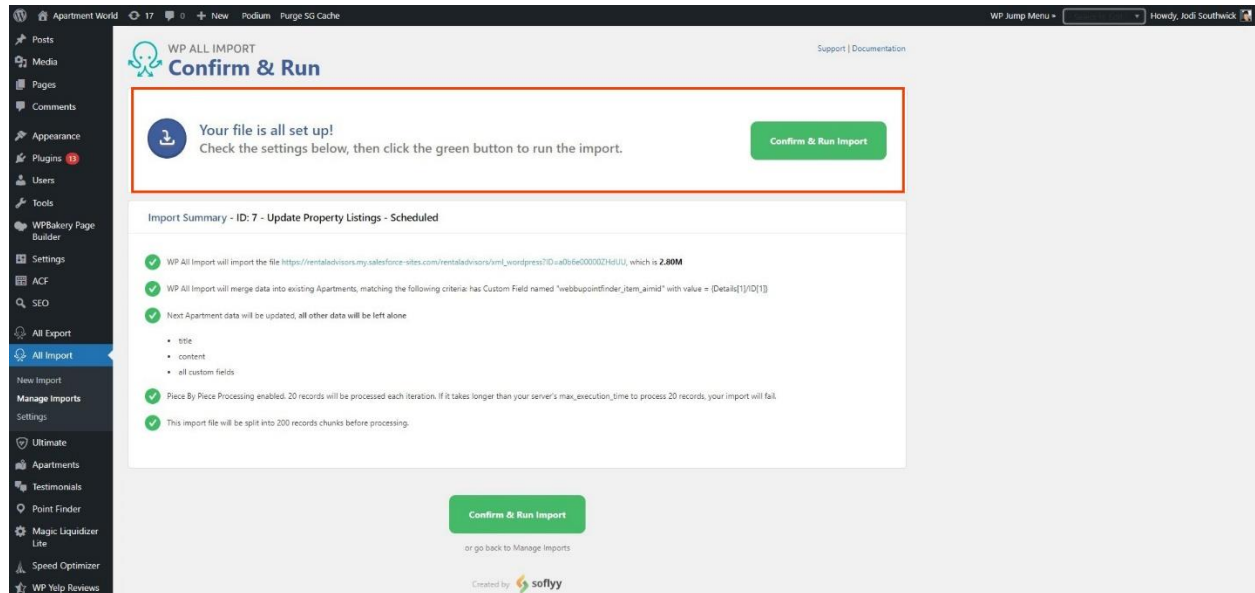

Featured Image

To show a featured image on your listings and grids, the data feed includes a link to a single featured image name. Many WordPress themes require a downloaded image in the media library in order to display a primary image on a grid or neighborhood page. For this reason, we do provide one featured image file in the data feed that you may download to your server if required.

When you reference the data feed with WP All Import, it looks like this: {Images[1]/FeaturedImage[1]}
